Must be 16 years of age or older and have a minimum grade 10 education or equivalent

SIN Card or a government document listing full name and SIN

#### **Proof of Education**

Ontario High School Transcript with 16 + credits, High School Diploma or College/University Degree

#### Tools

A basic hand tool set and personal protective equipment (Will be provided by Miziwe Biik)

# General Carpentry Apprenticeship

A total of 7200 hours

- Work experience
  - About 90% of total hours
- In-school training
  - About 10% of total hours
    - Exterior Finishing
    - Framing
    - Formwork & Foundations
    - Finishing (Walls & Ceilings)
    - Interior Finishing



# Salary

#### Hourly wages increase every 1800

hours, according to apprenticeship term

- First term: \$ 24.44
- Second term: \$ 29.50
- Third term: \$ 34.55
- Fourth term: \$ 41.98

A fully-trained journey level Carpenter currently earns \$ 48.49 per hour



# In-school Training

#### Three blocks of in-school training

- Basic (8 weeks)
- Intermediate (8 weeks)
- Advanced (9 weeks)

Apprentices are responsible for keeping track of their own work hours; obtaining an employer's verification signature; and submitting them monthly to the CCAT



# Basic Level Schooling

- 8-weeks full-time
  - All day from Monday to Friday
- Passing grades are 60% or higher
  - In each of four subjects:
    - Safety, Materials, & Tools
    - Plans, Specifications, & Codes I
    - Estimating, Calculations, & Layout I
    - Metal Cutting & Welding


